In order to support ongoing communication with local leaders of Guam and the CNMI, members of the Navy team leading the effort to prepare a supplement to the 2015 Final Mariana Islands Training and Testing (MITT) EIS/OEIS would like to provide an informational briefing regarding this effort. It is our desire to discuss the purpose and scope of this supplemental analysis and to receive any questions you may have.
